Industrial Visit to Securities and Exchange Board of India(SEBI)

Two batches of approximately 60 students each from BCOM and BMS, accompanied by Prof. Chandrakant Sonawane, Prof. Vinda Paralkar from junior college and Prof. Shreya Lalwani of BMS department, visited the institution. The sessions were graced by ingenious speakers of SEBI who threw light upon the various functions of SEBI and other vital attributes that play significant role in regulating the daily operations of the stock market. The students were informed about the different cases where SEBI would intervene to protect the interest of investors and the extent of their regulatory framework which bestows SEBI with authority to take action in such cases. The speakers also made time for an interactive round with the students, where in all the questions asked by students were meticulously answered.
