The flagship event of GLC for the year 2018-2019 was 'Vigyapan Nu Pagalpan', a creative event aimed at spreading the language and literature of Gujarat, and with an intention to teach students a few concepts of advertising. It was held on 21st August, 2018. The participants were in teams of three or four. They had to make a newspaper advertisement followed by a television advertisement which had to be enacted.

The Gujarati Literary Circle and Marathi Literary Circle had organized Navratri Celebrations on 12th October, 2018. The college looked like a mini Gujarat bursting with enthusiasm, with all the students dressed up in traditional Gujarati attire and dancing to the rhythmic Garba beats.
