A one-day Industrial Visit to Tarapur was conducted on 21st January 2019. A group of 40 students along with Mrs. Karishma Khadiwala and Mrs. Sunita Rai participated in this event. The students visited Kokuyo Camlin Ltd. and were greeted by Mr. Ajit Rane (Sr. Manager) who briefed us on the history of the company and the plant. Further the entire process of lead and

paint manufacturing was shown and explained in detail. After gaining a lot of knowledge about

Camlin, the group proceeded for a hearty lunch.

The students were then taken to D'decor home fabrics Pvt. Ltd. where the officials showed them the robotic warehouse for the raw materials. The warehouse can contain up to 84500 containers at a point of time. Robotic warehouse helps to save space, manpower and increases accuracy. The group was then taken into the weaving department and the entire process of cloth weaving was shown. A Q&A session was organised by the officials to answer queries. All the products produced in this factory were polyester based and 60% of the produce was for exports. The finished products were classified into grade A, B & C products and accordingly further processes were conducted. The visit ended with refreshments being served by the industry.

The trip ended with the students gaining a lot more industrial knowledge that they previously had started with and it proved to be a very fun and informative experience for all.
