The academic year was a busy one for Women Development Cell of R. A. Podar College of Commerce and Economics.

The first activity conducted by the forum was a Self Defence Workshop organized in association with Podar Judoka Club for students of the junior college section where students were taught basic self defence tricks and given training to save themselves from danger.
