Enigma



On 8th March 2021, the Women Development Cell organised a special program to commemorate the 26th International women's day celebration. This year's theme was 'CHOOSE TO CHALLENGE'.

The program was divided into two sessions:

- 1) Women's Day celebrations with female teaching and non-teaching staff
- 2) Women's Day celebration with students.

Women's Day celebration with Female Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff:

A Saraswati Vandana performed by the students marked the start of the event. The teacher in charge, Dr. Mrs. Tejashree Patankar gave an articulate talk on Savitribai Phule, followed by a cordial address, welcoming the audience to the event. She also spoke a few words on this year's theme 'CHOOSE TO CHALLENGE'. The Principal then addressed the teaching and non-teaching staff members. Women's Day celebration with Students:

This session also began with a Saraswati Vandana performed by the students. It was followed by a short film presentation based around the pressing issue of sexual assault against women. The teacher in charge and the Student Secretary shared their views on this issue and opened up this topic for further discussion to all student members. After the screening and discussion, a Sound Mind Management session was held by Mr. Jusstine Shon, followed by a self-defense workshop in collaboration with Podar Judo club in which students learnt many techniques virtually and practiced the same during the session. The session ended with the vote of thanks by the Student Secretary of WDC.



Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Webinar

On 3rd January 2021, The Innovation Cell in collaboration with DIYA Mumbai's #GyanSabha series conducted a webinar on 'Skill Development & Entrepreneurship.

The speaker of the webinar was Mr.S Ramadorai, who is the head of Tata STRIVE, Tata Technologies, TISS, NIAS, SRCC, PHFI, and ABF. He talked about how entrepreneurship is an individual's ability to turn ideas into action, as it is essential to promoting innovation, competitiveness, and economic growth. He also explained the benefits that entrepreneurship skills provide in our personal and professional life and how fostering an entrepreneurial spirit supports the creation of new firms and business growth. Overall, the students found the webinar to be informative and interesting.



Blood Donation Camp (Churchgate Railway)

On 20th January 2021 the NSS Unit in collaboration with Jagjivan Ram Hospital (Western Railway) and Lion's Club, Byculla organized a blood donation camp at Churchgate station. The volunteers tried to create awareness about the current times and requirements of blood in blood banks. They convinced the commuters in and around the station about the importance of donating blood. The volunteers were able to convince 70 people for the donation, out of which 56 were found eligible.

National Youth Day

On the occasion of Swami Vivekananda's birth anniversary, the NSS unit celebrated National Youth Day, on 12th January, 2021.

The theme of this year's National Youth Day was 'Channeling Youth Power for Building our Nation.' They conducted 3 activities namely: digital poster-making, video-making, and tree for life under the guidelines of MDACS.



Financial Modelling and Valuation

On 15th January 2021, Career Guidance Forum organized an online session on financial modeling and valuation with Prof. Ronak Gala. The session was based on financial modeling concepts and their processes.

Mr. Gala gave an in-depth breakdown on the topic using MS Excel and Powerpoint. He also broke down the complex process of financial modeling into the following steps:

- 1. Understanding business
- 2. Customizing the template
- 3. Input historical financial & operational data
- 4. Forecasting financial statements
- 5. Rationalizing assumptions
- 6. Valuation

The students didn't shy away from interacting with the speaker. In the end, Mr. Gala highlighted that financial modeling and valuation are growing fields bound to have a broader scope in the near future.

Articleship Briefing Session 2020-21

On 11th January 2021, the Briefing Session for Articleship was conducted for students registered for Articleship Week 2020-21.

Each session was conducted by 2 speakers- 1 speaker provided details regarding the Articleship Week, CV Format, and Debar Policy while the other one answered the queries of the students. All the necessary information regarding the format of the drive, types of firms, and the recruitment process was conveyed to the students.



KHELAIYA EVENT (LIVE HOUSIE)

KHELAIYA EVENT (LIVE HOUSIE) was conducted by Gujarati Literary Circle on the 18th of January, 2021. This event was an attempt to share the details of the rich Gujarati culture in a fun way.

The event required participants to draw a housie ticket and fill in numbers from the list of clues provided to them. During the event, the organizers posed questions with their answers hidden in the clues given. After every 5 questions, the right answers were discussed along with some facts around them. Participants were given tasks like writing their names in Gujarati, tongue twisters, reciting a poem in Gujarati, and identifying famous Gujarati personalities.

Intercollegiate Web Seminar with PCGT

On 20th January 2021, a session on 'Dialogues for Democracy: Lessons from Diversity' was conducted by NSS Unit and Enigma Enchancia in Collaboration with Public Concern for Governance Trust. The Chief Guest for the session was Mr.Anil Swarup (Former Coal and Education Secretary, Government of India). The session also marked the presence of PCGT Chairman Mr. Julio Ribeiro, Miss Rekha Sahani, and the Principal.

Mr. Swarup gave his insights about democracy, diversity, and the Nexus of Good. He also gave a realistic account of his life during the service. He emphasized on self-development and its relation to attaining success in life. He expanded his thoughts mentioned in his book "Ethical dilemmas as a civil servant", which has previously served as a guide for many UPSC Aspirants. 200 volunteers in total were watching the live session through YouTube.



Marketing Quiz

On 28th January 2021, Career Guidance Forum organized a Marketing Quiz focusing on how effective marketing can help businesses generate more sales. The quiz featured the knowledge of marketing strategies that helps one to get an edge over other competitors and also gave a brief overview of the rising demand for marketing experts in the industry.

Placement cell office bearer selections

On 12th December 2020, The Placement Cell had opened registrations for new members from FYBCOM, SYBCOM, FYBMS, SYBMS, FYBAS, and SYBAS. They had received 178 registrations in total. Every year, the recruitment process consists of two rounds: group discussions and personal interviews. This year three rounds were included in the process. The first round was an MCQ test wherein a candidate's communication skills, technical expertise, and problem-solving abilities were put to test. For this round, 109 candidates took the test out of which 60 were shortlisted for the next round.

In round 2 a written test was taken to judge the candidate's writing skills when replying to an email. The results of Round 2 were announced on the 9th of January 2021, followed by Round 3 of personal interviews on the 10th and 11th of January, 2021. After the personal interviews, five students were selected from FYBCOM, two from SYBCOM, five from FYBMS, one from SYBMS, and one from FYBAS.



Fundaz Apna Apna

On 4th March 2021, Fundaz Apna Apna was held under The Accounts and Financial Circle of Podar. The event was judged by Prof. Hetvi Dedhia. Fundaz Apna Apna was a financial journalism event wherein participants had to submit a video of the topic assigned to them. In the video, they had to break down their topic in layman's terms avoiding jargon. The event ended with the judge giving her feedback, followed by the declaration of results shortly after.

Group Discussion Week

On 18th January 2021, the Group Discussion Cell organized a GD week. It was judged by the alumni of our college, Mr. Dhruvil Kanadia who had been the secretary of the Group Discussion Cell and the Joint Secretary of Gujarati Literary Circle for the academic year 2019-20.

The theme for the GD week was 2020: The Aftermath of an Unforeseen year.

The discussions were based on the economical, environmental, and social changes that took place in 2020. Participants not only put their views and thoughts forward in a convincing way, but were also actively listening, with a view to understanding the perspectives of others involved. Towards the end, the judge gave his tips to the participants for a better experience.


Podar Pageant 2020 Launch Event


Étude de Cas

On 28th January 2021, Life Enrichment Centre organized an insightful session on Goal-Setting along with Mrs.Trupti Vyas.




Champak Waache Chappo


Founder's day

The event received a good response and the two winners were announced based on their scores.




Kalachya Padadyaad
