The cell by organizing different events and seminars also helped to guide students regarding creativity, innovation in businesses, and entrepreneurship.

Event 1:

The Innovation Cell conducted the event, 'Snap Stories' which enabled students to explore their creative and imaginative side by connecting different pictures into a story. The event was initiated by Dr. Amitha Sehgal Ma'am welcoming the students to the first event conducted by the Innovation Cell. A briefing on the Innovation Cell and its objectives were discussed with the students in attendance. Event 2:

The Innovation Cell members along with other students of the college attended DIYA Mumbai's #GyanSabha series which conducted a webinar on the topic, 'Responsible Innovation' for the students. The topic was explained by Adv (Dr.) Prashant Mali, the Founder & President – Cyber Law Consulting (Advocates & Attorneys). As the Chairman of Cyber & Law Foundation – A Trust, he has been involved in work related to awareness of Cyber Law, IPR, Privacy Law & Cyber Security. He is a foremost expert in the field of cyber-crime and law. During the webinar, he explained why the concept of digital citizenship is becoming more and more recognized as people communicate, shop, and share information online, which creates a greater need than ever to practice responsible habits - Understanding and operating according to the concept of responsible digital citizenship helps us respect, educate, and protect yourself and others online. He also explained that being a responsible digital citizen means using technology appropriately and operating online safely and knowledgeably. The webinar ended on a positive note receiving an overwhelming response from the students.

Event 3:

The Innovation Cell members along with other students attended DIYA Mumbai's #GyanSabha series which conducted a webinar on the topic, 'Skill Development & Entrepreneurship' for the students. The topic was explained by S Ramadorai, Head of Tata STRIVE, Tata Technologies, TISS, NIAS, SRCC, PHFI, and ABF, who explained how Entrepreneurship is an individual's ability to turn ideas into action. Fostering entrepreneurial spirit supports the creation of new firms and business growth. It includes creativity, innovation, risk-taking, as well as the ability to plan and manage projects to achieve objectives and is seen as vital to promoting innovation, competitiveness, and economic growth and provides benefits regardless of whether a person sees their future as starting a business. He explained how the entrepreneurial spirit can be used across people's personal and working lives as they encompass creativity, initiative, tenacity, teamwork, understanding of risk, and a sense of responsibility.
