French Frydays: Back Home

For the first event of the new year, the Forum members decided to bring back one of the most awaited and well-received events of the previous year... French Frydays: Back Home. Akin to last year, Fridays were dedicated to delivering weekly online activities and games enriched with fun and intellect related to everything French. French Frydays: Back Home stems from a Comics theme and the Forum members worked diligently to showcase the undertone of the event throughout. This event was brought to the audience through 'stories' on the official Instagram account of the French Forum and summed up a total of three sub-weekly activities/games:

Tintin in the Land of the Jigsaw:

Resemblant to its title, students were encouraged to crack daily categorical jigsaw puzzles. A story with a link redirecting to the unsolved jigsaw puzzle was shared on French Forum's Instagram handle every day at 06:30 PM for four days. Interactive games like Words in a word, Prefixes, and Suffixes were carried out. Students marked their participation by sending their responses to the questions and replying to the forum account's story.

Valeria Quizzards:

For the last event under French Frydays: Back Home, the members borrowed some inspiration from the prodigious mastermind character of "Valeria Richards". A multitude of categorised French-related picture quizzes was put up on the Forum's Instagram account following the same schedule. Identifying the pictures by replying to the stories reserved a student's participation for the event.

The event spanned out for 19 days and was received well not only amongst the students of the college but also midst colleges sprawled outside Maharashtra. The commencement of the first activity week on the 27th of January and the end of the last activity week on the 15th of February marked the completion of French Frydays: Back Home.
