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#### MATHEMATRIX

Mathematrix 2021 was an intercollegiate Pan-India level and inter-school fest organized by the Mathematics Association of Podar from the 27th of August 2021 to the 29th of August 2021. The social initiative activities were conducted on the 17th and 18th of August for the specially-abled students. This was followed by some Pre Events for the schools and colleges.

Two webinars were conducted on the 20th and 24th of August featuring Mr. Archit Gokhale, a budding astronomer and a student of our college, and Mr. Prasan Kamat, director of Career Launcher, Mumbai respectively.

An opening ceremony was held on the 26th of August, along with the Chief Guest Ms. Sejal Vora. The ceremony began with a prayer and the Principal's speech followed by a webinar by Ms. Sejal Vora on Data Storytelling.

The main events began on 27th and went on till the 29th of August. The flagship event for both schools and colleges was Raiders of the Lost Arc. The fest also featured other events like The Natural Suspects, 2001: A Math Odyssey, 20000 Logarithms under the sea, and The Fast and the Factorial for both colleges and schools. The fest had more than 50 contingents with around 2400+ registrations for all the events.

The closing ceremony was held on 29th August in which all the winners were declared. Children's Academy, Ashok Nagar was declared as the overall winning school and Narsee Monjee College of Commerce and Economics was declared as the winning college.





#### FINACC



On the last day, they organized an informative session highlighting the effects of global warming and displayed a video made for the same.






#### WEBINAR ON DISASTER MANAGEMENT



## BHOOMIPUTRI: FUTURE OF WORK


