Since becoming an actuary demand clearing of a specific set of the exam, the speaker informed the students about the syllabus of Casualty Actuarial Society (CAS) exams. CAS is the world's only actuarial organisation focused exclusively on Property and Casualty Risk with over 9000+ members across the globe.




QUOTE UNQUOTE - AN OPEN MIC EVENT




THE GD WEEK


CHAAL KARIYE CHARCHA


