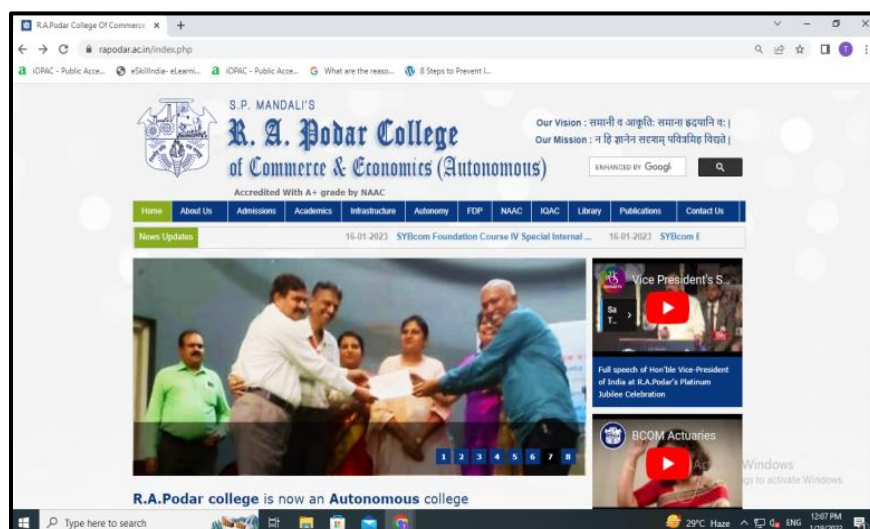


WEBSITE COMMITTEE
