The recruitment process went without any hiccups and more than 30 students got successfully placed.




Orientation Programme

Career Guidance Forum organised an interesting webinar on "Understanding the Basics of Stock Markets" on 5th October, 2020, from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Zoom. Mr. Sri Harsha explained the basics of stock market with the help of a case study and also gave some insightful examples from his life experiences.

He talked about things like: share markets, stock exchange, difference between SENSEX & NIFTY and market capitalisation which form the essential structures of Stock Market . Furthermore, he also explained how exchanges segregate stocks and listed few top stocks & industries.

Students found the session to be engaging and didn't hesitate to pose questions during the Q&A round at the end.

Snap Stories

- 3) Role of social stigma in mental illness.


Later, the professor-in-charge of Life Enrichment Centre asked the students to take pledges of self acceptance and love; and to always help a friend in need.

Ms. Hansu is a Waste Management professional and the founder of Har Ghar Hara Ghar, a social enterprise. She has spent almost 5 years in the field of Waste Management and has recently moved into the space of Waste Management Training. She talked about different types of wastes and the techniques to manage each one of them. She also talked about the common misconception around waste being entirely useless and how we can reuse it to our advantage. During the Q&A session, students came to know about a plethora of brands which continue to take up measures reducing wastage from their own sites.

Stock It Up

On 11th November 2020, Entrepreneur Development Cell collaborated with Mr. Hemal Shah for a webinar 'STOCK IT UP'. Through the course of the same, they had a purpose of talking about the dynamics of the stock market and requirements of a rational and street-smart investor.

In this session he explained how the stock market works, and also talked about ideal conditions to enter and exit. Further, he discussed factors that affect the stock market like- Demand and Supply, Debt-free, Dividend etc. He also talked about the importance of embracing risks while investing.



Resume: The Lasting Impression

On 24th October 2020, the IQAC department presided over a webinar namely "Resume: The Lasting Impression" in collaboration with Mr. Jaimit Doshi, Executive Vice President at Aditya Birla Sun Life Insurance Company. The event began with the Vice Principal madam addressing the students about the purpose of the webinar. The webinar was conducted for FYBCom (Actuarial Studies) and FYBMS students. Mr. Doshi spoke about how one's experiences in various capacities at the student level make up one's resume. He briefed the students about the various expectations of interviewers in the current scenario. He also explained as to how one's participation and involvement in co-curricular events stands out in one's resume.

The webinar wound up with Mr. Doshi clarifying the students' doubts and queries.

Learning the Art of Commodities and Derivatives Market

On 11th November 2020, the Entrepreneur Development Cell of Podar organised a webinar exclusively for the finance students on the topic: learning the art of commodities and derivatives market. The guest speaker for the webinar was Mr. Hemal Shah--currently a director at CHL Stock Concepts Pvt Ltd. He has ten years of teaching experience and is known to conduct various workshops and courses on financial and derivatives markets.

The webinar started off with him explaining the basics of commodities and derivatives market and how it is different from the equity stock market. He talked about how investors can gain exposure of commodities by investing in companies who do the same or via future contracts. Further, Mr. Shah showed them a live demonstration of how commodities are traded and taught them the difference between call and put.

He then shared his secret mantra which he personally swears by. The webinar ended with an interactive Q&A round.



National Equality Day

On the occasion of National Equality Day on 31st October 2020, NSS Unit conducted a webinar in association with Sakshi Foundation.

The discussion was based around the grave issue of 'Child Sexual Abuse' and Dr. Aditi Kishore--the guest speaker of the event- talked about nature of sexual abuse and the laws pertaining against them. Informational video clips regarding different cases were displayed in the webinar and in the course of the Q&A session closing the event climatically, she orated on the questions from the participants.

Cyber Security: Key to a Safer World

Mr. Bhavesh Shah is a Chartered accountant and a certified information systems auditor. He currently works as the Vice President and head of information technology audit at DBS Bank Mumbai. Apart from that, he also explained how cyber security can become a unique career opportunity.

During the Q&A session, he talked about many apps that the students could use to safeguard their identities.



Pitch it to Win it

On 24th October 2020, Entrepreneur Development Cell along with Mr. Sameer Kothari piloted a webinar named 'pitch it to win it' for students curious about entrepreneurship and business plan strategies.

Mr. Sameer Kothari is a Podar Alumni, a CA by profession, and has completed his MBA from Cornell Johnson Graduate School of Management. He is the Managing Director at Vanity Case, which runs on the ideology of providing world class solutions for the FMCG industry.

He talked about what makes an ideal entrepreneur and then divided the participants into groups of 10 and asked them to come up with an innovative product name and a pitch to present the same. In the next activity, each group had to decide their brand names and appoint their managing directors. In the subsequent rounds, the groups had to narrow down their business models, their investments, expenses, the main areas of revenue and also perform environmental and SWOT analysis. They had to calculate their products/service's potential size of the market in measurable units as well. The participants were happy to be a part of this interactive webinar.

Intra- Collegiate Essay Writing Competition 2020
