FINACC 2017 was a accounting and finance fest encompassing four events, namely,Quiz-o-ccounts, Esploro Presentado, Business Analyst and Etude De Cas. FINACC 2017 was inaugurated by the Honourable Vice Principal of the College, Mrs. Kavita Jajoo in the presence of other professors and students of the college.



Quiz-o-ccounts was a fun based accounting quiz with four rounds such as MCQs, Crosswords, Betting Round and Treasure Hunt. There was a participation of 28 teams (i.e.56 participants) from various colleges across Mumbai. The first prize was bagged by the N. M. College of Commerce and Economics, Villeparle.

Esploro Prezentado was a research paper presentation competition aimed at developing the instinct of research amongst the students of Commerce faculty. Esploro Prezentado got a moderate response, and the winner for the event were from H.R.College.

Business Analyst was a start-up simulation event, where the participants had to come up with a business idea and convince the venture capitalist to invest in their business. The event got a response of than 18 teams (i.e. 36 participants), and the winner for the event from H.R.College.

Étude De Cas was, where team were presented with issues faced by a company and a specific amount of time to prepare a presentation with solution or suggestions to resolve the problem. This was a new addition to the accounting fest and got an whopping response of around 20 teams and the winner were from H.R.College.

In nutshell, Finacc 2017! got most response, a total of 130 participants from different colleges of Mumbai, for being 3rd year since commencement and the all four events were carried out smoothly. The participants liked the initiative and gave positive feedback for the event.

- **♣** The Runner Up were Umang Gupta and Aashay Patankar


In nutshell both the events were carried out smoothly .The participants liked the initiative and gave a positive feedback for the event.
