R. A. Podar College offers four year programs at the undergraduate level under the NEP 2020:

Bachelors in Commerce:

B.Com at R. A. Podar College (Autonomous) is a program designed to give the learner skill and knowledge required for a successful career in the exciting world of Commerce and Finance. During the program, the aspirant will learn about the general business principles, and at the same time, study core commerce subjects such as finance, economics, accounting, taxation, business management, etc.

Bachelors in Commerce (Actuarial Studies)

B.Com(Actuarial Studies) at R.A. Podar College (Autonomous) is a self-financing program designed to give the learner skill and knowledge required for a successful career in the exciting world of commerce and Finance. The learner shall acquire a strong foundation in business and commerce and gain skills in communication, teamwork and leadership, develop critical and creative thinking, as well as an understanding of how different cultures do business. The program is designed to make a learner combine skills from Mathematics, Statistics, Economics, and Finance to assess, evaluate and manage future financial risk, thereby addressing a wide range of practical problems in long-term financial planning and management. The program has been accredited by Institute of Actuaries of India (IAI), since the academic year 2024-25. Students are eligible for exemptions in 7 papers of IAI (CS1, CS2, CM1, CM2, CB1, CB2, and CB3). Provided the students meet the eligibility threshold percentage.

The program is designed to be challenging and highly rewarding for those wanting to enter the financial services, insurance or superannuation industry in a quantitative role. Learners would be able to develop the technical and specialist skills needed to pursue the role of an actuarial analyst.

Bachelors in Commerce (Accounting and Finance)

Accounting and Finance form the backbone of any business, providing the necessary tools to evaluate financial health, ensure compliance, and drive strategic decision-making. With the evolving landscape of global business and financial regulations, the demand for skilled professionals in accounting, taxation, auditing, and financial management has significantly increased.

India's financial ecosystem is undergoing rapid transformation with digital finance, regulatory changes, and corporate governance playing a crucial role. To capitalize on these emerging opportunities, students need specialized and focused knowledge in accounting and finance. This programme is designed to equip learners with the analytical and technical skills required in modern financial decision-making and regulatory compliance. As an Autonomous Institution, we at Podar have structured this programme to be application-oriented, ensuring that learners are job-ready upon graduation. The curriculum integrates theoretical knowledge with practical applications, making students competent in financial analysis, corporate finance, taxation, and risk assessment. The key career avenues for graduates of this programme include financial accounting, costing, auditing, taxation, financial consulting, banking, corporate finance, and investment advisory services.

UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMS (UGP)

B.Sc. (Data Science and Analytics)

Companies are racing to hire people who can manage large databases and extract insights important for business, government, and academia. The ability to work with large, unstructured data sets and extract vital insights is a desired attribute for a worker. The need for data scientists is so strong that the Bureau of Labor Statistics predicts that there is going to be a visible upsurge in the requirement of data science professionals in India. Similarly, at the graduate and professional level, there's a growing need to catch up, and an opportunity to strengthen career paths and job prospects by adding data science skills. Podar college wishes to address this humongous opportunity by providing a wholesome curriculum which combines data science and analytics. This program also gives opportunities for the learners to become self-made professionals and start operating on their own.

B.Com (Financial Markets)

Finance is an important domain in commerce Education. The steady growth of financial markets in India duly supported by the Government initiatives, has opened up several career opportunities. To utilise the emerging opportunities in the employment space there is a need to have focused knowledge in the financial markets' domain. With the Indian financial markets getting integrated with International markets, there is a need for knowledgeable and skilled man power. This programme will fill the existing gap. As an Autonomous Institution we at Podar have made the programme experiential oriented such that the learners will be job ready and will be in a position to contribute while becoming a graduate and after graduation. The main areas of career are trading and broking in capital markets, equity and other security analyst, mutual funds, credit rating, investment and merchant banking, research and advisory services like mergers and acquisitions, commodity trading, risk management in financial markets, and portfolio management.

AICTE approved programs (DTE CODE 03568)

Bachelors in Management Studies (BMS)

The BMS department strives to mold its students into competent managers and entrepreneurs so that they rise par excellence. The programme is managed professionally and time to time guest lectures are conducted by experts from the corporate world and even from abroad.

BBA (Shipping and Logistics Management)

The globalization of business and the consequent competitive pressures have placed demand on logistics operations and thus the use of third-party logistics services by manufacturing companies has become a common practice in the last decade. The important challenge that prevails in logistics industry is dearth of skilled and knowledgeable manpower. Logistics Function Activities are Transportation, Shipping, forwarding, deconsolidation, contract delivery, freight bill payment/ audit, cross-docking, household goods relocation, load tendering, brokering. Warehousing, Storage, receiving, return goods, Inventory management Forecasting, location analysis, network consulting, slotting/layout design, Order processing, Order entry/ fulfilment, consignee management, call Centre Information System, EDI, routing/scheduling, bar-coding, RFID, web-based connectivity, tracking and tracing. Value- added activities such as Packaging, marking/labelling, billing, call Centre activities, customization are also a function of Logistics.

Evaluation at RAPCCE(A)

A student shall be evaluated under the semester grade point average (SGPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) System. The assessment is carried out in twoparts as follows:

Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE): to be conducted by the subject teacher all through the semester; CIE includes Internal Assessment tests, assignments, tutorials, problem-solving, group discussions, quizzes, seminars, mini-project, and any other innovative method developed by the teachers. The evaluation pattern for 40 marks for internal examination shall be decided by the respective departments and the final marks out of 40 shall be submitted to the COE in the prescribed format.

Semester End Examination (SEE): shall be a written examination (max 60 marks) on the dates fixed by the Examination Committee.

Students' performance in a course shall be judged by taking into account the results of CIE and SEE individually and also together. **Individual passing for both is necessary.**

The evaluation pattern for each semester of the Core courses shall be 60:40, wherein 60 Marks shall be assigned for a written examination (Semester End Examination or External Examination) and 40 marks would be for internal evaluation.

In case the student is unable to attend the external examination then, the student shall be given an opportunity to appear for the additional external examination provided the leave of absence is approved by the Principal.

In case a student fails in the internals then he/she shall appear for a special test of 40 marks which shall be held along with the SEE (ATKT).

Evaluation Method Passing (minimum score)

Continuous Internal Evaluation Score: 40%

Semester End Examination Score: 40%

Student's disability gracing:

If the student comes under the category of Learning Disability and others, then the Government rules shall be followed and not the general or special gracing norms.

Unfair means in the examination:

The College has a zero-tolerance policy towards adoption of unfair means in the examination. exams. The Unfair Means Enquiry Committee (UMEC) established according to University of Mumbai guidelines, investigates reported cases of unfair means. Students have the opportunity to explain their actions, and each case is reviewed independently. The committee prioritizes guiding students towards ethical behavior rather than solely imposing penalties.

Photocopy and revaluation:

Students can request photocopies and revaluation of their assessed answer papers. Notifications regarding this process are posted on the College website after the announcement of SEE results. Students must apply according to the instructions provided in the notification.

Code of Conduct (Students)

A Podarite is one who stands tall among all men, distinguished by his scholarship, versatility, and above all DISCIPLINE and DIGNITY. Students must therefore take special care to observe the following rules: -

1. **Attendance at lectures, class assignments and class participation are compulsory. A student has to attend college on at least 75% of the days on which classes are conducted. Only if a student is present for all lectures, class assignments, and class participation, for the day, will it be counted as one day's attendance. The attendance at various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities shall be noted by the college authorities.**
2. Students are required to wear their identity cards when they are on the college campus and must produce them whenever called upon to do so by the authorities.
3. The conduct of the students in the class as well as on the campus shall be such as will cause no disturbance to fellow students, teachers, or other classes.
4. Students must not loiter about or congregate in and around the college premises while the classes are in progress.
5. Students shall do nothing either inside or outside the college that will, in any way, interfere with the orderly functioning of the college.
6. Students are prohibited from carrying mobile phones into the examination hall. Carrying mobile phones into the examination hall amounts to unfair means.
7. In the name of the college or premises of the college, no society, association, organization, etc. shall be formed, no collection be made, no tickets be sold, no function or meeting be held, and no person be invited to address the students, no socials are arranged, nothing be printed and/or circulated without the written permission of the Principal. No notice shall be put up on the notice boards (including Blackboards) or announcements be made without the Principal's written permission of the persons authorized in the matter concerned.
8. Students should, in their own interest, read the notices placed on the notice boards from time to time. Students are required to download the college app as well as visit the college website www.rapodar.ac.in regularly. Students shall adhere to the Social media policy of the College. 9. Every association/organization formed under the auspices of the college is in charge of a Faculty Member nominated by the Principal. Students shall submit all the relevant notices, applications, budgets, accounts, annual reports, etc. only through the concerned Faculty Member.
10. All meetings, functions, programs, and official outings of the authorized and duly constituted associations, societies, councils, etc. of the college must be organized/conducted under the mentorship of the Faculty-in-Charge with the prior written permission of the Principal. However, the college shall not be responsible for any untoward incident that may occur on such occasions.

Code of Conduct (Students)

11. Students are required to note that they are not permitted to organize class/group picnics, socials, and outings in the name of the college. Disciplinary action will be taken against the organizer and those who accompany them.
12. Agenda of meetings, subjects of debates, and guest lectures arranged by the various authorized associations of the college must have the prior written approval of the Principal. No unauthorized person shall arrange any activity within or outside our premises in the name of the college.
13. Any matter published in the college magazine, wallpaper, newsletter, and the Press must have the prior written approval of the Principal. Any publication without the prior written approval of the Principal shall be treated as unauthorized.
14. Students must not indulge in political work on the college premises.

College Library

The College library has a rich collection of 76046 books and 2568 CDs / video tapes. The library subscribes to over 42 periodicals and 8 newspapers. It has a spacious and airy Reading Hall, which provides seating accommodation for 350 students at a time. Normally, the library is open to the students and staff between 8:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. In order to keep pace with strides made in educational technology, a Library Management software, ISLIM and the library have been computerized. OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) and Internet facilities are made available to both students and teachers. The library provides a Book Bank facility for deserving students, for one academic year at a time. It also renders other services like Reference, Circulation, Documentation, Photocopying, Bibliography, Inter-library loan, Current Awareness service etc. It also conducts Library Orientation Programmes for Freshers in order to make them aware of library facilities and services offered to them.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LIBRARY

- Absolute SILENCE must be maintained in the Library
- Library membership is provided to all the students of the college free of cost.
- A member will get two library cards, one for a Textbook and one for Non-Text Book. Library books must be returned on time.
- In case of late return of books, a fine of Re. 2/- will be charged per book for each day after the due date.
- Reference books i.e. Encyclopaedias, Directories, Handbooks, Dictionaries, Atlases, Maps, etc. are meant exclusively for use in the library only.
- OPAC (Computerized Database) for author, title and subject have been provided for tracing books out of the library collection. Library orientation is conducted for freshers. OPAC is available 24*7 and it can be accessed on the mobile phone also.
- To get a book for home reading, all particulars on the Demand Slip must be properly filled in and the demand slip must be handed over at the counter.
- Books in the Reading Hall Counter will be issued for reference in the library only. These books shall not be taken out on any account. Infringement of the rule will cost the defaulter a fine of Rs.10/- per day.
- Holders of the Readers' tickets will bear full responsibility for books issued on their tickets.
- If Identity cards or Readers' ticket is lost, a fresh one will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/- and or Rs. 25/- respectively.
- Cell phones are not allowed in the Library. Keep them off while present in the library. Cooperation of students is earnestly requested observing these rules and regulations.
