1) FINACC INTER 2019

3rd August 2019, Saturday

The fifth intercollegiate event of Accounts and Finance Circle of Podar, FINACC 2019 was successfully concluded on 3rd August, 2019. FINACC 2019 was an Accounting and Finance fest encompassing four events, namely, Quiz-o-ccounts, Esploro Presentado, Business Analyst and Etude De Cas.

FINACC 2019 was inaugurated by the Chief Guest of the event, **Mr. Sachin Seth** (National Leader- Ernst & Young) and the Honorable vice Principal of the College, **Mr. S. Natarajan** in the presence of other professors and students of the college.

There was an insightful lecture by Mr. Sachin Seth on Start-ups and Fintech held for the participants and the students of the college.

Quiz-o-ccounts was a fun based accounting quiz with four rounds such as MCQs, Crosswords, Betting Round and Treasure Hunt. There was a participation of 23 teams (i.e. 46 participants) from various colleges across Mumbai. The first prize was bagged by Jai Hind College.

Esploro Presentado was a research paper presentation competition aimed at developing the instinct of research amongst the students of Commerce faculty. There was a participation of 8 teams (i.e. 16 participants) and the winners for the event were from K.C. College.

Business Analyst was a start-up simulation event, where the participants had to come up with a business idea and convince the venture capitalist to invest in their business. The event got a response of than 9 teams (i.e. 18 participants), and the winners for the event from K. C. College.

Étude De Cas was, where teams were presented with issues faced by a company and a specific amount of time to prepare a presentation with solution or suggestions

to resolve the problem. This event had 7 teams (14 participants) and the winners were from H. R. College.

The best contingent trophy for FINACC 2019 was bagged by **H.R. College**.

In a nutshell, FINACC 2019 got a great response from over 9 different colleges of Mumbai and all the events were carried out smoothly. The participants liked the initiative and gave positive feedback for the same.

Esploro Presentado


